Dear Parents,

I am so sorry that after all of our hard work since the announcement last week to plan for the return of our children tomorrow, we have a new announcement at the last minute which leaves us having to plan all over again.

As such I am afraid that the school will need to close for children tomorrow, Tuesday 5th January, so that we can plan rotas for the return of key worker and vulnerable children from Wednesday 6th January, as we are aware that there may be different numbers of children to those that we had in the summer. This also means that the Hub will close for tomorrow as well.
