Dear Parents,

I hope that you have had some sort of break and family time over the last fortnight.

This is just a reminder that the children return next **Wednesday, 14th April**.

The only main change from before Easter will be that there will no longer be a staggered start and end to the school day by house group. We would like all Year groups from 1 to 6 to come in between 8.40 a.m. and 8.50 a.m. and for Reception 8.50 a.m. and 9.00 a.m.

I would also like to remind you that we have requested that only one adult drops off and to make sure that you enter and leave the site promptly in order to help maintain social distancing. You may need to stand back at the end of the school day whilst collecting your children to allow for better spacing - our staff team will understand this and be patient.
