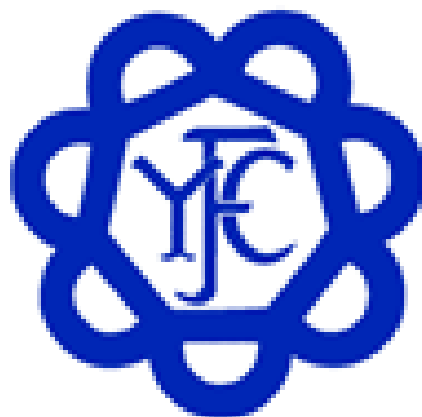

## WHAT IS A YOUNG FARMERS' CLUB?

- A Young Farmers' Club is an organization that serves the youth of the community and seeks to increase their knowledge and appreciation of rural life.
- Young Farmers are not necessarily sons and daughters of farmers, but are young people from every walk of life who have an interest in the countryside.
- A Young Farmers' Club is a self-governing body, electing its own officers from among its members, choosing its own programme and managing its own affairs. The Club Leader and Advisory Committee are there to help and advise.
- The programme is varied and provides for educational, social and recreational activities, as well as agricultural activities of a practical nature.
- Young Farmers' Clubs have been formed in urban as well as rural districts. The growing membership of the movement represents a real "brotherhood of the land".
